

Families are responsible for student transportation to and from Beaumont School.

Some options that are helpful to families who are arranging bus service are:

- Beaumont Car Pool Lists: In August, Beaumont parents will be asked if they want to participate in a car pool list.
  - This list will be circulated in August to participating Beaumont parents who can then work together to arrange rides for their students. We provide this connection between cooperating families as an option for student school transportation. *Beaumont does not arrange, schedule, or guarantee carpool situations.* Beaumont does not have control over individual family situations and does not assume responsibility or liability for carpool arrangements (potential conflicts may include absences, bad weather, accidents, etc.).
  - Beaumont does not participate in ongoing management of carpools.
- Public School District (School Bus) Transportation: Beaumont Families must contact their public school transportation department directly to confirm service and to make arrangements for their student. *If* a public school district DOES offer transportation for high school students, then the family must register directly with that Board of Education Transportation Dept. Parents or guardians should contact their School District Transportation Department directly to arrange bus service as soon as Beaumont registration is complete in the Spring. Early communication with your school district will alleviate confusion when school begins in August.
- Public Transportation (RTA): RTA is an option if available in the student district. Families are to contact RTA directly for information on routes and times available to them in their specific community.
  - *For students living in Cleveland proper, RTA will give bus passes on a semester-by-semester basis to students in need of this service.* Families are to call the Cleveland Board of Education (Transportation Department 216/838-0963) directly themselves and then Beaumont will arrange to pick up the passes to give to the student at school. It is emphasized that a parent or guardian must personally contact that department to register their student.
