- Student has a desire to help create a better and more peaceful world through intercultural understanding and respect.
- Student has successfully taken at least two honors courses during her sophomore year, maintaining a “B” average in each of the courses.
- Student has exhibited discipline, self-motivation and possess effective time management skills.
- Student and/or parent attends an IB Information Session virtually or in-person.
- Student submits a signed copy of the *Beaumont IB Enrollment Contract* to Mrs Hoelzel before class registration during the second semester of sophomore year.
- Student has completed all prerequisites, including Algebra I, Geometry, and Algebra II.
