- G. Further aesthetic awareness in all aspects of the school's total program

Beaumont School's National Art Honors Society Bylaws:

- 1. A member must be a student in good standing: A student will be ineligible to apply if she has more than one detentions over the course of two consecutive quarters.
- 2. A member must pay her annual dues collected at the beginning of each new chapter year
- 3. A member must attend the chapter's <u>mandatory</u> monthly meetings. (an excused absence will be permitted **once** with a note from a parent or guardian)
- 4. A member must participate in ___2_ of our projects, activities and fundraisers
- 5. A member must be a high school student enrolled in 10, 11, or 12 grade at Beaumont School and be enrolled in a Fine & Applied are course for the entire school year.
- 6. A member must have and maintain a __3.0 __cumulative GPA
- 7. A member must have and maintain at least an A in their selected visual art courses
- 8. To graduate with a NAHS honors cord, a member must remain in good standing until the graduation date
- 9. The NAHS Creative Board will be nominated and elected into office for the following chapter school year at the conclusion of the previous chapter by majority votes of the chapter members; details of the responsibilities of the Creative Board will be provided prior to election
- 10. Creative Board members must be present at <u>all mandatory meetings</u> as well as other executive meetings called by the NAHS sponsor
- 11. In the event of an infraction of the rules, a review by the Creative Board and sponsor(s) will be conducted. If the individual is an officer, he/she will not participate in the decision-making process. This applies to all community laws as well as school and chapter rules.

Creative Board Duties:

 Preside and manage, along with the sponsor, the quarterly and executive meetings of this chapter. They will assist with delegating responsibilities of the members for projects, activities and fundraisers

- 2. Preside and serve as the chapter's program chair
- 3. Keep all minutes of the meetings, a record of all business and all records on file; including the service hours of each member.
- 4. Receive and disburse all funds of the chapter and keep an accurate account of receipts and disbursements in accordance with school regulations.
- 5. Contact members for reminders and updates for events
- 6. Orchestrate the annual bake sale fundraiser if applicable
- 7. Provide rides (if necessary & able) to MOCA

Membership Selection:

Dates: A new chapter's roster must be completed by the end of the first quarter of each new school year, along with members submitted dues in full.

 A student must submit an application form for membership to the sponsor by the end of september in order to be selected and approved for the chapter.

NAHS Dues:

Dues contribute to the annual membership fee, miscellaneous supplies (induction ceremony) and service projects

The National Art Honor Society (NAHS) was established by the National Art Education Association (NAEA) in 1978 to inspire and recognize students who have demonstrated passion and dedication through their art and community service.

WHAT IS NAHS'S PURPOSE?

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HOW DO I APPLY & WHAT ARE THE REQUIREMENTS?

**In order to apply, you must meet the following requirements:

- 1. Be enrolled in any Visual Art (this includes Fashion) course for the entire school year
- 2. Hold and maintain an A average in your Visual Arts class
- 3. Maintain a 3.0 GPA
- 4. Be a student of good standing (A student will be ineligible to apply if she has more than one detentions over the course of two consecutive quarters).
- 5. In 10th, 11th or 12th grade
- **In order to be a member of NAHS for the academic year and earn recognition, a student must meet the above 4 requirements AND...
 - 1. Pay the annual dues
 - 2. Participate in at least two activities and/or service projects a year
 - 3. Attend monthly mandatory meetings

NOTE: You DO NOT have to be a member of NHS to be a member of NAHS

If you meet the following above criteria and want to apply, simply pick up an application form from Mrs. LoPresti or download it from the Beaumont School website under Student

Life/Clubs. For the 2018-2019 school year, <u>applications are due no later than Friday</u>
September 6th. Notification of acceptance will be sent out the following week.
