BEAUMONT

Beaumont School will:

- Live our Ursuline mission and core values of educating young women who are global citizens, intellectual risk-takers, unapologetically confident, and authentically Ursuline.
- Lean into our belief that relationships matter and that our community is at the core of what makes a Beaumont education special.
- Follow our policies and procedures in a fair and balanced manner, following our student handbook when standards are not met.
- Encourage and engage in honest, direct, timely, and respectful two-way communication toward all community members.
- Provide a safe, inclusive, and intellectually robust environment that makes room for different points of view, reflecting the diverse population of which our school serves.
- Be professionally accessible and responsive with a commitment to acknowledge parent and student inquiries within 24 hours.
- Commit to keeping our Beaumont community well informed through regular communication systems.

STUDENTS

Students will contribute to this community by agreeing to:

- Represent themselves at all times as a Beaumont woman both in person and online by being respectful, kind and considerate toward all members of the community.
- Advocate for themselves by communicating respectfully, honestly and openly with teachers and parents about academic and personal concerns.
- Commit to achieving growth as a student, a woman of faith, and a leader, in a way that demonstrates respect, integrity and empathy for others.
- Attend school regularly and be punctual for classes. When class is missed, accept responsibility for making up missed assignments and assessments.
- Take responsibility for their behavior, knowing there are fair and appropriate consequences when standards are not met.
- Remember that you are a learner for life. Take responsibility for being a learner by engaging actively in the learning process and seeking help when needed.

PARENTS

To realize the most effective partnership, we expect that all parents will:

- Understand and support the school's policies, procedures, and curriculum.
- Provide a home environment that supports positive attitudes toward school and reinforces the school's Ursuline mission.
- Financially support the school through timely payments of tuition and, when able, support the school's philanthropic efforts.
- Treat each member of the community with respect, assume goodwill, and maintain a collaborative approach when conflicts and challenges arise.
- Seek to resolve problems and secure information through appropriate channels (i.e. teacher, Dean of Students or Dean of Academics, Principal, President – in that order).
- Support the school through volunteering in parent clubs and attendance at school events.
- Share with the school any religious, cultural, or personal information that the school may need to best serve their child and the school community.
- Respect the school's responsibility to do what is best for the entire community, while recognizing the needs of an individual student.

STUDENTS

- Participate fully, respectfully, and attentively in all-school assemblies, presentations, faith services, liturgies, prayer opportunities, service projects, theology classes, and theology field trips as opportunities to respect and learn about Catholic faith practices.
- Use appropriate channels to resolve conflicts and seek help from school staff when needed.
- Contribute to a positive school culture by being inclusive, supportive, and collaborative with your Beaumont sisters, and with faculty and administration.
- Take care and respect the campus environment, care for our common home, and follow all campus and security/safety procedures.

PARENTS

- Understand and support the school's handbook, code of conduct, and policies.
- Support the Ursuline mission of the school.
- Be supportive of the school's commitment to a diverse and inclusive community.
- Acknowledge that the payment of tuition is an investment in the education of the child, not an investment in the ownership in the school.

The school reserves the right not to grant re-enrollment if the school administration reasonably concludes that the actions of a parent or guardian make a positive, constructive relationship impossible or otherwise seriously interfere with the school's accomplishment of its mission and educational goals.
